

Philanthropic Donations

Sanofi supports philanthropic giving through partnerships with not-for-profit organisations and patient advocacy groups. Through carefully considered donations and contributions, we fund initiatives that align with our mission to improve lives and strengthen communities.

Each partnership is thoughtfully evaluated to ensure alignment with our values and maintain independence from commercial interests. These strategic philanthropic efforts reflect our commitment to corporate social responsibility and our belief that positive change requires collaboration across the community.

What is a Philanthropic Donation?

- A financial contribution unrelated to Sanofi therapeutic areas to a non-profit or a charitable organisation to support its own Philanthropic cause.
- This can include support for the mission of a non-profit organisation or an independent Philanthropic initiative by the organisation.
- There should also be no direct return for Sanofi.

Submission Method

To apply, a written request must be submitted to communications.anz@sanofi.com. If you don't have a contact person, please use our <u>Contact Us page</u>.

Essential Request Components

- 1. Purpose and Project Details
 - Detailed project description must be sufficiently detailed to allow proper assessment
 - 2. Clear explanation of how the donation will be used
 - 3. Alignment with charitable or humanitarian purposes
- 2. Organisational Information
 - 1. Status of the requesting organisation (charitable organisation, non-profit, etc.)
 - 2. Due diligence documentation (if not already on file or if older than 2 years)
- 3. Financial Information
 - Cost breakdown budget (required when the request is linked to a specific project)
 - 2. Specific amount requested
 - 3. Timeline for when funds are needed
- 4. Operational Details
 - 1. How the donation will be implemented
 - 2. Geographic scope (which regions/countries will benefit)

3. Expected impact and beneficiaries

Important Notes

- Requests must demonstrate independence from Sanofi's commercial interests
- All requests go through due diligence review to ensure the organisation is in good standing

Process Flow

- 1. External organisation submits request through Cybergrants
- 2. Request is routed to appropriate Budget Owner
- 3. Due diligence verification (if needed)
- 4. Review and approval process through CSR representatives
- 5. Finance Controller approval
