

## **Sponsorship of Healthcare Professional to Medical Education**

Sanofi supports the enhancement of medical knowledge and the quality use of medicines provided at independent third party meetings. Where directly related to a field of expertise, Sanofi can support the participation of Healthcare Professionals in these Events, with a preference for virtual attendance.

All support must meet the requirements of local regulatory Codes; in particular the <u>Medicines</u> <u>Australia's Code of Conduct</u> and Sanofi policies.

## **Submission process**

- A written Request for Sponsorship is required from Healthcare Professionals; it is preferable the Request for Sponsorship is in the form of a letter on letterhead from the requestor, however a business email from the requestor may be acceptable.
- The Request for Sponsorship must meet the requirements listed below.
- If approved by Sanofi, a sponsorship agreement will be provided for signature, setting out the terms of the sponsorship.
- This agreement must be signed and returned to Sanofi prior to any travel taken by the HCP or by the time the meeting commences, whichever occurs first.

## Details of the Sponsorship Request should be submitted by the requestor and include:

- Name of the meeting
- Organisation or group holding the meeting
- Date of meeting
- Meeting venue (if a face-to-face meeting)
- Components of sponsorship requested, i.e. Registration for virtual attendance or physical (virtual preferred)

If requesting to attend congress/meeting physically, rationale as to why this is the preferred option

- Flights
- o Accommodation
- Transfers
- Agenda for the meeting including medical content or website link to the meeting if available
- Detail on how the meeting is relevant to field of expertise and the benefit of participation in the meeting
- Detail on how the requester will communicate relevant information gained at the meeting to peers/colleagues post meeting
- Business address and contact details of the requestor.
