Sanofi has strong foundations in Canada going back over a century, and operates world-leading R&D and biomanufacturing facilities in Toronto.

We employ more than 2,000 people across Canada and contribute to the creation of thousands of associated jobs in many sectors. We also help develop tomorrow's talents through CO-OP programs.

Opened in 1917, our Sanofi campus advanced some of the greatest contributions to public health in Canada and globally. We carefully curate this heritage through our on-site museum and continue to bring innovations to Canada and the world with our state-of-the-art manufacturing facilities with advanced automation.

Sanofi also operates an artificial intelligence (AI) centre of excellence located in Toronto that uses leading technologies to develop world-class data and AI products that accelerate research and development.





Our Toronto campus is one of the largest vaccine research and development and manufacturing sites in the world. Each year, we protect over seven million Canadians against infectious diseases and export vaccines to over 60 countries around the world.

In Canada, Sanofi has a strong commitment to R&D, investing approximately \$1.2 billion CAD in R&D over the last decade to develop innovative therapies for diseases such as cancer, diabetes, and multiple sclerosis.

We're on track to deliver over \$2 billion in new infrastructure investments by 2028 to:

- Meet demand for pediatric and adult booster vaccines with a new building completed in 2023
- Build a new vaccine manufacturing facility dedicated to influenza vaccines and future pandemic response. The new facility is expected to be operational in 2026.
